I have information on my website and in my office that will educate you about your procedure. I also have hundreds of before-and-after photographs of my patients to give you an idea about what to expect from the results.

WHAT MAKES YOUR PRACTICE DISTINCTIVE?

Our focus exclusively on facial rejuvenation is unique. Also, we perform all of our procedures under local anesthesia, meaning we do not put the patient to sleep. Everyone walks in and then walks out after a procedure.

Safe procedures, quick recoveries


Most people have extremely busy lives, and Dr. Harley understands this and therefore offers safe procedures with minimal downtime and maximal results. "Everyone deserves the chance to feel beautiful without taking weeks out of their lives to recover from extensive procedures. We use local anesthesia for our services, which means that patients don't have to be put to sleep. The most popular procedure is my signature Biltmore Lift, a minimally invasive necklift and facelift that is complete in two hours. Using a short scar technique, I restore a youthful appearance to the patient without the undesirable 'pulled' look. What's also great about the facelift we perform is that other procedures can be done at the same time, such as eyelid lifts or injectables, so the patient only has to have the oral sedation once and can emerge anew. They walk in, have the procedure and walk out the same day!" Biltmore clients come to Dr. Harley for his skilled hands and precise results, appreciating that he listens closely to their desired outcomes and delivers consistent results.

DO YOU HOLD ANY SPECIFIC MEDICAL/PROFESSIONAL POSITIONS?


I am proud to serve regularly at the Asheville Veterans Affairs hospital, providing plastic and reconstructive surgery services to the veterans who have served our country.
